EFSUMB offers an annual 500 euro prize for the best published paper, that is an original article published in a journal up to three years before EUROSON 2017. The EFSUMB member's National Society should propose up to two articles as soon as possible. All the details of the criteria for consideration are listed on the EFSUMB website under the Research heading. If you are under 39 years of age and are nominated by your National Society you can have the chance to win the Young Investigator Award prize at EUROSON 2017 Ljubljana, Slovenia, which has been increased to 3000 euro. The prize money can be divided between the best technical and clinical presentation.

The Walter Krienitz Society offers an annual prize of 500 euro for the best oncological abstract submitted to a EUROSON Congress. The abstracts will be considered by a specially appointed jury of EFSUMB Committee members to evaluate the best paper.

Elasto liver guidelines

This is the first update of the 2013 EFSUMB Guidelines and Recommendations on the clinical use of elastography, focused on the assessment of diffuse liver disease. The first part (long version) deals with the basic principles of elastography and provides an update of how the technology has changed. The practical advantages and disadvantages associated with each of the techniques are described, and guidance is provided regarding optimization of scanning technique, image display, image interpretation, reporting of data and some of the known image artifacts. provides clinical information about the practical use of elastography equipment and the interpretation of results in the assessment of diffuse liver disease and analyzes the main findings based on published studies, stressing the evidence from meta-analyses.

The role of elastography in different etiologies of liver disease and in several clinical scenarios is also discussed. All of the recommendations are judged with regard to their evidence-based strength according to the Oxford Centre for Evidence-Based Medicine Levels of Evidence. This updated document is intended to act as a reference and to provide a practical guide for both beginners and advanced clinical users.

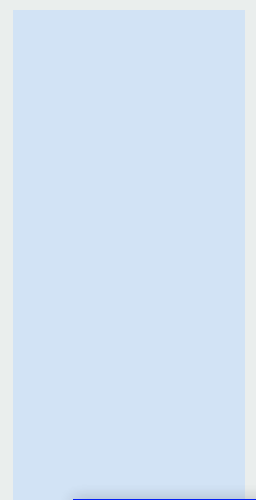
